were aware she may have issues with her oesophagus and trachea, and as soon as she was born she was whisked up to St George's Hospital in London for further tests. At two days old Leah-Marie endured an operation lasting over ten hours, and she has had over a dozen operations since. Recently another operation of over ten hours took place. Throughout this time Mariah and Steve have been supported by Ronald McDonald House in Tooting. They have been able to stay there, individually or together, so one of them is always close to baby Leah-Marie. Their three other children have also been able to stay there when visiting t heir sister. Staff at the house are so caring and have always gone that extra mile to support the whole family.
