

# Upper Beeding and Bramber Art Trail.

Start at St Peters church.

## 1. Carved heads

Go through the main door and look up around you. Now turn around 360°. How many heads can you see?

## 2. Triptych

Go through the main door and turn right until you see a painting made from 3 panels. Look carefully at the painting. How many people can you see?

## 3. Stained Glass Windows

Now head towards the pulpit and turn right. This area is called the sanctuary. Look at the stained glass window on your right. Name the flower in the window?

Go to the back left hand corner of the sanctuary and look for a wooden picture of angels with gold detail. Open up the door to find a locked box with a cross on it. What do you think is hidden behind the locked door?
