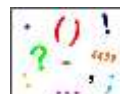
Safety of Children and Parking

Sadly, we are still receiving complaints about parents' inconsiderate and dangerous driving and parking in front of the school, as well as in and around the roads surrounding the school.

This morning, David Barling - Cabinet Member for Residents' Services, came to see for himself the issues we are having and in particular, the appalling state of the non-parking zone in front of the school. He will be working on behalf of the school to secure a date in the imminent future for this to be resurfaced. This will include very clear signs and markings showing **that it is not a place to park or drop off outside of school**. Governors are also exploring other avenues to support the safety of our children based on the survey completed by parents last term and we will keep you updated on this.
