We are also very excited to be working with the Rainbow Theatre Company again who will be teaching the children more about life as a child in Roman Britain. We will also be enjoying some super art activities during the rest of the day.















<u>Thursday 16th November – trip to Fishbourne</u> <u>Roman Palace</u>

We are planning our first trip of the year and will be visiting Fishbourne Roman Palace on **Thursday 16th November**. This valuable educational visit will provide the children with a greater understanding of Roman Britain. The trip will involve visiting Fishbourne Roman Palace where

we will explore the grounds and experience workshops that will bring this terms topic work to life. The















workshops will include activities such as learning how to write with a stylus on a wax tablet, spinning wool, make a mosaic, and working in a 'Roman' kitchen. The trip will help to bring the past to life and provide the children with a memorable learning experience to enhance their understanding of their topic.

We will need to set off at 9:00am sharp and would ask that all children are in school by **8:50am** at the latest please. We will arrive back towards the end of the school day. Children will need a packed lunch as we are off site so please **DO NOT ORDER A HOT SCHOOL MEAL.** Children are also encouraged to bring water bottles and a piece of fruit from home for a snack. We will be wearing school uniform for this trip, but please bring a sensible coat and wear sturdy footwear as part of the day will be outside.

If your child suffers from travel sickness, please obtain a form from the school office, and hand completed form and medication to your child's teacher on the morning of the trip.

The children do not need to bring any money with them as we will not be visiting the gift shop on site.
