## Arts Week – Monday 24<sup>th</sup> to Friday 28<sup>th</sup> June

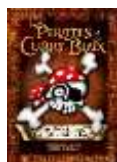
This year our fantastic Arts Week, which is being organized by Mrs Taylor, is titled ‘Off to see a World of Art!’

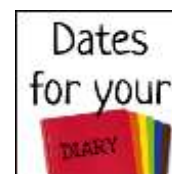
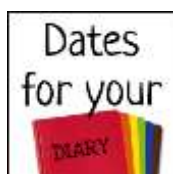
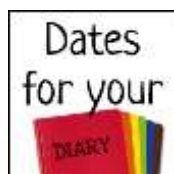


### Golden Play Day Winners
