Pupils and staff are invited to wear their jeans or something denim to school, such as a denim skirt or pinafore dress, for a £1.00 contribution. This can be either in cash or via sQuid. Children should still wear their normal school uniform yellow tops and sweatshirts/cardigans please. This is to raise money for 'Jeans for Genes'.

'Jeans for Genes' is a national charity raising money for children with genetic disorders, and we hold a fundraising day for them every two years. Their aim is to fund the care and support these youngsters need now and further develop the research which could change their futures.

In the UK, one baby in every 25 is born with a genetic disorder. Although individually these disorders can be extremely rare, together they are the biggest killer of children aged 14 and under.
