Dear Parents

Welcome back after the Easter holidays. It has been lovely to see the sun over the last few days but due to the British weather please can you make sure children have a rain coat and sun hat with them in school! It is also useful for them to have a named water bottle. Thank you for your help with this.

The children are coming home this week with their **Spring Term topic books**. I am sure you will agree they have created some super pieces. We look forward to reading your comments when you return them back to school.



**School Uniform** Please make sure that all school clothes are named as due to the variation in weather, children are leaving items of clothes all around the school as they get hot! As the weather gets warmer, can I remind you that summer uniform can be worn. We still expect children to wear suitable shoes to school - either black or brown shoes / sandals. Please could sandals have a back on them and offer a secure foothold. Flip-flops and crocs are not suitable for school. It is also useful for children to have a waterproof in their bag and a sun hat.

**PE Kit** Can I also ask that you make sure your child has their PE kit in school with suitable shoes to wear outside, e.g. trainers; and that everything is **named**. Thank you.

**Hair styles** Children are expected to have appropriate hair styles at all times – it should be tidy, of a suitable length and, when necessary, tied back to allow safe participation in classroom or PE activity.

**Hair should not be** dyed bright colours, two toned, or have shaved markings and only a minimal amount of hair gel / hairspray to be used as necessary. A completely shaved head is deemed inappropriate for school. Thank you for your support with this.



**Books!** Please could we ask you all to have a look at home for any books that belong to school. They will have our name stamped on the inside cover and they could also have coloured strips on the edge. Thank you in advance for your help – we are missing quite a few.

### **Extra Help for Low Income Families - Pupil Premium/Free School Meals Eligibility**
