## HISTORY

We will look changes in Britain from the Stone Age to the Iron Age. Areas of focus will include:

- Timelines and chronology
- Hunter gatherers and early farmers
- Transition from Stone Age to Iron Age
- Iron Age Hill roundhouses
- Stonehenge

Using evidence to find out about the past.

## GEOGRAPHY

- Focusing on the UK, naming and locating different places and developing an understanding of how these places have changed over time
- Using the 8 points of a compass
- Using symbols and keys on maps
- Incorporating fieldwork to observe, measure and record

## ART

- Experimenting with a variety of techniques (colour washing, charcoal, mark making, texture) to explore cave drawings and paintings
