## Reception and Key Stage 1 Sports Day 2024 Wednesday 19th June 2024



Now that Sports' Day is almost upon us, we would like to advise you of the arrangements for the day. Please talk to your child's class teacher if you have any further questions.

Sports' Day will take place on Wednesday 19th June on the school field. Parents and carers of children in Reception and KS1 are welcome to come into school to watch the events. The school

gate will be opened at 10:35am ready for a 10:45am start.

During the events, your children will be with school staff in groups. Siblings will be in the same groups. Please can we kindly ask that you don't encourage children to leave these groups to be with you, such as if they need the toilet! The sports will take place in a rotation, and you will be able to follow your child's group round.

At the end of the morning, the children will be taken back into school to get ready for lunch: HOT LUNCH Those children having a hot lunch will go into the hall as usual before going back outside. If you are able to stay for the lunch period, the children will join you on the field after their meal - please do not enter the hall. PACKED LUNCH Those children having a packed lunch will be able to join you for a picnic on the field. If you are unable to stay for the lunch period, staff will accompany them.



FUBS will be selling ice lollies and raffle tickets during the lunch break so please remember to bring some cash if you wish to purchase!

Lunchtime will finish at 1:00pm and all Reception and KS1 children will go back into school for afternoon lessons. Those parents still on site may leave the field, unless you are staying for the afternoon.

If you are staying on to see your KS2 child, please may we ask you to move yourself and all your belongings to behind the roped area by 1:15pm. School will finish at the normal time with the usual pick up arrangements.



For safeguarding reasons there will be NO access to the school buildings throughout the day, apart from to the toilets in the Blue Building which will be available for parent use.

NO ENTRY

Children in Key Stage 1 should come to school wearing their full school PE kit. Children in Reception will change at school so can they please remember their full kit including appropriate footwear. All

children will need a water bottle and a sun hat, and have sun cream applied before school.

We are holding a Sports Day practice on Monday 17<sup>th</sup> June, so please can KS1 wear their PE kit to school, and Reception bring theirs in, including appropriate shoes.
