SPORTS DAY Thursday 27th June KS1 (Reception, Year 1 and Year 2) will be taking part in the morning and parents are welcome to come along to support - they start at 10:45am. KS2 (Years 3, 4, 5 and 6) will be starting their games at 1:15pm. You are warmly invited to come along and watch and you are also very welcome to bring a picnic to enjoy with your child/children over the lunch period between 12:00 – 1:00pm. FUBS will also be selling ice lollies over the lunch break. All children who are having a hot meal provided by Chartwells will be eating in the school hall as usual. KS1 will return to their classrooms after lunch where normal lessons will resume, therefore **only the parents of children in KS2** will need to stay in the afternoon. This is always a lovely day and a pleasure to see so many families – we look forward to seeing you all at our Sports Day.



This year, due to the events and number of children involved in the KS2 Sports Day, please can we ask that all families remain on the parent side of the track. We will ensure children have plenty of access to water and keep them out of the sun when we can. If we feel a child needs their parent, we will not hesitate in letting you know.

KS2 Production – “Ye – Ha!”

The children, Mr Moule and staff in year 5/6 are currently busy rehearsing and practising every spare minute for our end of year production. This promises to be another spectacular show and one not to be missed! We will be performing the play on **Monday 1st and Tuesday 2nd of July at 5:30pm**. Tickets are available to purchase online via sQuid at £2.50 each. We are making this small charge for admission as on previous occasions, and any monies raised are put towards the costs of staging this and other productions. Please note that tickets are limited to **two per family** to start with – if you would like to go on the waiting list for extra tickets, please contact the school office in writing to request this. Children will get to see the dress rehearsal of the show in school time. Actual tickets will not be issued for these shows to save paper and cut costs, but they must be purchased via sQuid to secure a seat.



New Classes and Annual Reports – Wednesday 10th July

Next year, we will have 4 classes in Y5/6 and 4 classes in Y3/4. Therefore we will be using the Blue Building as a classroom base for one of our Y5/6 classes.

On Wednesday 10th July the children will have the opportunity to spend the morning in their new classroom with their new class and teacher. They will bring home their report on the same day, together with a letter explaining the assessment systems and an evaluation form to complete about your child's report and year in general.
