Year 5/6 Ancient Greek Wow Day Monday 10th June 2024

Dear Parent/Carer,

To support the children's engagement with this term's topic It's All Greek to Me, we will be organising an Ancient Greek Wow Day on Monday 10th June 2024.

We are very lucky to have been able to book the Hobgoblin Theatre Company to come into school. Children will join Perseus as he begins the perilous journey that takes him far from home to the land of the hideous Gorgons where he must use his cunning to defeat Medusa - or die! In this original version of a classic Greek myth the children will learn about many aspects of life in Ancient Greece. Filled with facts and hugely fun, this show is written specifically to appeal to a Key Stage



2 audience. Children will watch the performance and then participate in a follow-up workshop.

So that children are fully immersed in the day, please could your child arrive at school dressed as an Ancient Greek citizen. Ancient Greek clothes were styled simply and both sexes wore a long tunic called a Chiton; this could be easily made out of an old bed sheet with a cord to tie around the middle. We have provided a few ideas below to help with selecting the appropriate costume.
