Dear Parent/Carer

We have had a busy few weeks since being back with children out on trips and all our lovely new Reception children starting school. Thank you for all your support for the Connors Saunders Foundation we raised £265.75! We also are pleased to tell you that we have achieved the Healthy Schools Rating Scheme – **GOLD!** Thank you to all children, parents and staff that took part last Summer Term.

**KS1 Coffee Morning Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> September 9:00 – 9:45am** We are looking forward to welcoming our KS1 parents into school tomorrow to meet class teachers and enjoy time with each other. This is an informal gathering and parents will be able to come into school to the Main Hall once the children have entered and got to their classes.

**“The Gingerbread Man – Harvest Celebration” – Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> October** Our Year 3/4 classes are leading an assembly for Harvest. This year, parents of children who are in Mexico, India and France classes are warmly invited to join us for our Harvest Festival assembly at **9:15am on Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> October**. Unfortunately we will have to limit this to two people per family.

We will be sharing our Harvest assembly with the children on Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> October.

This year, we would like to support our local food bank for the homeless based at Shoreham and would ask children to bring in donations of **tins or packets of food**. These items can be brought into school from **Monday 4<sup>th</sup> October**. Thank you for your support.

**Flowers, fruit and vegetables** to help decorate the hall would also be appreciated. It would be helpful if these things are brought to school on **Monday 11<sup>th</sup> October** so that they can be attractively displayed for the special assembly on the Tuesday and Wednesday.



**It's Good to Grow from Morrisons** We are now collecting for this scheme so we can hopefully get some free gardening equipment for our school. If you shop at Morrisons, please download the MyMorrisons app, sign in or register to MyMorrisons and select us as the school you wish to collect for. You can then scan the app at the checkout or use online when shopping – thank you!

**Contacting the Office** Please could you add children's class details to emails when contacting the school. Thank you for your support.

**Communication Box** To save queuing at the office at peak times, our red communication box is now back up and running again if you just need to hand something in. This box is emptied late morning every day.

**Children Starting School for the First Time** Applications are open from **Monday 4<sup>th</sup> October** and an information leaflet will be emailed out shortly for any families who have potential new starters. Please come and speak to Mrs Gilliam in the school office if you have any questions.



**Healthy Snacks** If your child would like a snack at morning break-time, we would be grateful if you could ensure that they bring in either fruit or vegetables. Please **do not** send your child to school with **sesame seeds, nuts, peanut butter or products containing nuts** for their morning snack or lunch as we do have children in the school who have severe allergies to such items. Grapes should be cut in half please. Fruit and/or vegetable morning snacks are provided by school



for all children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2, but children can bring in their own if they prefer. Please note these should only be fresh fruit or vegetables for morning snack.

We also ask children to bring in a **named, clear plastic** bottle for drinking water in class. These should not be used for drinking squash or fruit juice in class. Bottles are available from the school office for £1.00.

**Is Your Child Entitled to Free School Meals?** Your child might be able to get free school meals if you get any of the following:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on - paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit - if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

Please remember that even if your child doesn't want to have the free meal, they could still benefit in other ways through the Pupil Premium funding we would receive as a school. For more information, please speak to Christine Gilliam in the Office.

**You will receive an important brown envelope by the end of this week containing Data Collection Forms** As you are aware, we hold information regarding your child at school which we update annually. We would be grateful if you could check the details, amend anything which needs to be updated, sign where indicated and return the form to the School Office **by Friday 8<sup>th</sup> October**. **Please sign and return the form to the school office, even if there are no alterations to be made.** **Many thanks.**



**Cycling and Scooting to School** It is great to see children cycling and scooting to school. We have, however, noticed a number of children not wearing safety helmets, which are a requirement of the school cycling permits and important for the safety of your child. Please can you talk to your children if they cycle about the importance of wearing a bike helmet. We would also remind everyone that children/adults must not scoot/cycle once they are on school grounds. All children cycling/scooting to school should have a cycle permit and if your child needs one, please collect a form from the school office.

**Visitors and Volunteers** We are very happy to now have volunteers back in school. If you would like to help in your child's class or know someone who would like to help out, please let the class teacher know and contact Rosie O'Hara in the school office on [rohara.938@lgflmail.org](mailto:rohara.938@lgflmail.org) You will need to have a DBS completed and re-sign our visitors and volunteers policy as it has been so long since we have been able to have anyone in school.
