#### Parking before and after school

We have a new single yellow line painted opposite the school, restricting the times cars are allowed to park along this part of School Road. This is particularly at school drop off and pick up.

Sadly, we still have a number of parents who are parking inconsiderately on these lines as well as on the kerbs and blocking our neighbours' driveways.

We urge you to think about the safety of all our children. When you park in areas you shouldn't, you put yourself and others at risk. The only way we can ensure that children are safe coming into school is if **ALL** parents who decide to drive and drop off at school **do not park in unsafe areas or block the road**. We really do need **EVERYONE** to think carefully about this. Thank you.

Parents are not allowed to use the staff car park when dropping off or picking up children at the normal school starting and finishing times. Parking permits are available on a short term basis for any parent who is in need due to mobility/health issues. These need to be applied for from the School Office and must be displayed on the dashboard when using the car park.
