English

The children will be exploring Greek myths and legends. We will be focusing on storyboards and devising our own for myths and legends. They will use what they find out to write myths and legends based on their historical learning.

The children will also be practising their speaking, listening and drama skills for our Year 5 and 6 production.

This term the children will be learning skills and participating in the team sports of Handball and Rounders. After half term children will be developing their Tennis and Athletics skills.

Art

The children will be looking at Greek vases. Through this work the children will explore geometric patterns and how friezes tell a story. The children will create terracotta clay vases to apply their ideas to.

Technology

The children will design, make and evaluate a Greek Feast. They will explore the types of food the Ancient Greeks may have eaten and write a step-by-step recipe; listing ingredient and selecting appropriate equipment and utensils to use.

P.S.H.E.

All children will be looking at 'Changing Me' as we move towards the end of the year. We will also be looking at relationships with others and what makes a good friend. Year 6 will discuss transition to secondary school.

Computing - Film Making: the children will be creating a Horrible Histories type film about an area of Greek history/a Greek Myth. They will use Search technologies and Software; using digital recording devices to film and import into video editing software. In the second half of the term children will explore physical computing using Micro Bits. Children will also revisit Online Safety - keeping safe when using technology at home.

Science

Properties and Changes of Materials

The children will be investigating how materials are selected for different uses in relation to their properties. The children will explore reversible and irreversible changes through burning, freezing and melting.

The children will look at solids, liquids and gases considering how these mixtures can be separated from each other through evaporation, sieving and filtering.

History

The children will be learning about the chronology of ancient Greeks and studying events in detail. They will also be researching about how the ancient Greeks lived and their everyday lives. They will find out about their beliefs and how these are told through myths and legends.

Geography

The children will explore the location and characteristics of different societies in Greece and the importance of empire.
